#### **Directions and Helpful Information:**

- Applications must be received in the FYAO office no later than November 23, 2011. Remember that you must obtain Dr. Gomez' signature to this Application, before you send it to the FYAO office, for it to be accepted.
- Competitors must perform one movement of a recognized work from the standard repertoire for their instrument, including any cadenzas appearing in that movement. Only standard orchestral instruments, including piano, are permitted to compete. The performed work must have a published and readily available orchestral accompaniment.
- Performances must be made from memory – no music is permitted, except for accompanists.
- Contact the FYAO office by January 1, 2012 if accompaniment is on any instrument other than piano, so that appropriate arrangements may be made.
- You must bring three copies of your solo part to the competition to deliver to the judges for their comments. Please number all measures.
- You are responsible for all arrangements between you and your accompanist regarding fees, rehearsal times, etc.
- Your performance time will be assigned to you in advance of the event.
